
### Goa trip

### Children's Freedom Movement

#### **Events:**

Established by A. S. Neill in 1921, Summerhill School is the oldest children's democracy in the world. Today, Summerhill is considered as one of the most successful, unique and revolutionary Schools in the field of Education.

Henry Readhead is a grandson of A. S. Neill and currently Vice Principal of Summerhill School. On invitation from Oasis, Henry visited India for the first time and spent a fortnight in a series of Programs across India. The Program was – 'Dialogue with Henry Readhead' & the theme was to discuss - How to inculcate democratic values in Schools, What freedom is for children & How to give it, and How children thrive maximum in such atmosphere of Freedom & Happiness.

Henry visited 7 places across India in 15 days and had a dialogue with @ 1000 School Principals, Teachers, Authorities, Parents, Children and people from organizations associated with Education & Children. He visited Oasis Valleys (Vadodara), Surat, Bengaluru, Delhi, Srinagar, Jammu & Mumbai during 25th August to 9th September.

### **Rallies**



Before the start of Boards Exams in Gujarat (10th & 12th Std.), Oasis organized awareness program to appeal to the parents & family members of students not to create pointless pressure of these exams on their children.

The program was organized in 3 cities of Gujarat - Surat, Ahmedabad & Vadodara. Leading citizens including Doctors, Social Activists, Architects, School Principals, etc. took part in them and appealed to all through Press & Media.





### Aisi Ki Taisi Movement:

The Aisi Ki Taisi Movement began with the booklets 'Exam ki Aisi ki Taisi' & 'Result ki Aisi ki Taisi' which are primarily written for students in general so that they don't lose heart, get frustrated or consider exams & scorecard as the finality of their life. Based on the booklets, 1-hour sessions were organized by volunteers for students of class 10th and 12th throughout the state of Gujarat & at Bengaluru as well. Booklets were distributed among these students eventually taking the message to parents, relatives, teachers, and principals.



#### **Principals Meet**

A special Principal Meeting was organized at Oasis Valleys on February 24 and 25, 2018 by Oasis; in which more than 100 Principals and Trustees of various schools participated. The main purpose of this Principal Meeting was to help their schools and surrounding children. They discussed how should be an ideal school and also discussed how they can be useful in their schools and surrounding children. Thus, this meeting ended with a note to help as many children as possible being role-model first.



## • HCJ: Hu Chhu Jyotirdhar Abhiyaan

The main objective of Oasis Jyotirdhar Abhiyaan is to rekindle the spirit of teachers to take charge of their duties and responsibilities as developer of intellectual, spiritual and moral qualities of students. They realize that children are the creator of future society and nation. Teachers need to be Role-models to the young generation by their actions, thoughts and speech - their overall life.

Oasis Jyotirdhar Abhiyaan, spreading across Gujarat, has taken a huge leap in 2017 by partnering with RMSA, Jammu & Kashmir which added 7 batches of HODs & HOIs for various districts of Jammu & Kashmir. In 2017 Oasis Jyoirdhar Abhiyaan was also launched at Mumbai, Maharashtra. In total 20 batches, some 400 teachers are passing through the processes of Self Leadership. Oasis Jyotirdhar Abhiyaan is becoming a strong support for Oasis Children's Freedom Movement.




