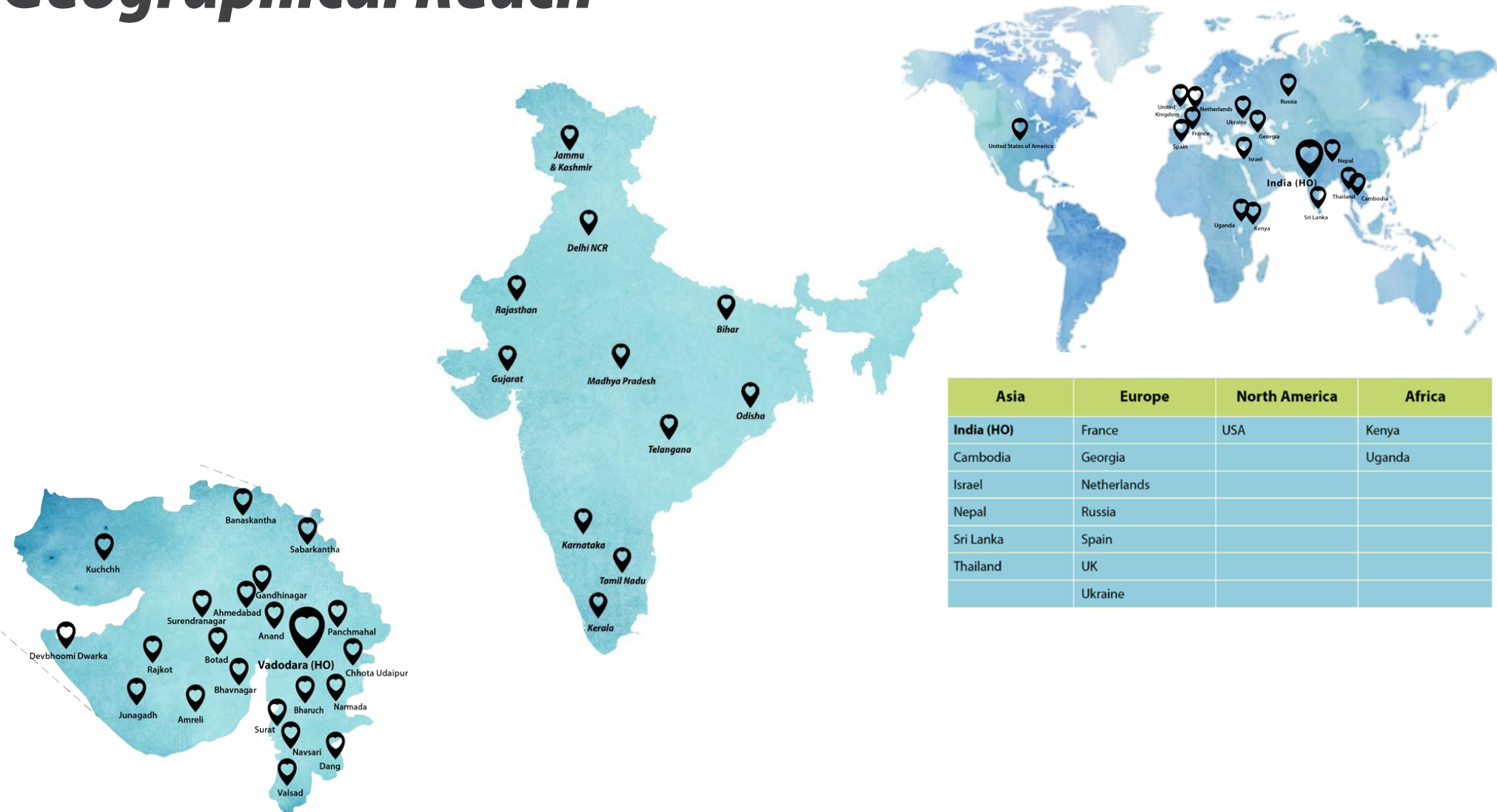

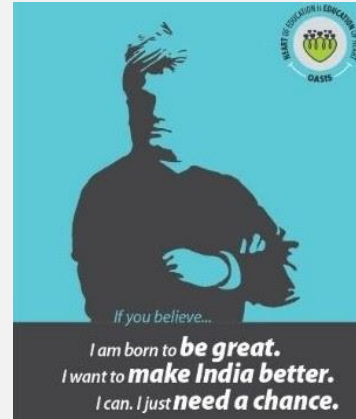

My Transformative Journey: Oasis Friendship Camping Experience

The adventure of a lifetime began on September 12 when our Oasis coordinator, Dr. Riyaz, made an exciting announcement as an Oasis essay competition was on the horizon! With four topics to choose from, anyone wishing to participate had to draft a 1000-word essay by the next day. Initially, the thought of writing such a lengthy piece was daunting, but I decided to embrace the challenge!

As I prepared to submit my essay, I turned to Allah in prayer, asking, "If this opportunity is truly good for me, please open the doors of Your mercy. If not, kindly close them." Days passed, and when the results were finally revealed, I was overjoyed to learn that I along with several schoolmates, had been selected for a dialogue session. Even more thrilling was the news that we were chosen for the Oasis Friendship Camping in Srinagar, scheduled for September 23. The word "camping" filled my mind with excitement, evoking visions of adventure and fun. With my parents' permission secured, my father dropped me off in Kupwara, where I traveled to Srinagar with my friends.

Upon our arrival in Srinagar, we quickly submitted our registration forms and were assigned our rooms. Not long after, a girl informed us that we needed to be ready for our first session at 11:20 AM. Though fatigue had set in, we eagerly participated in our initial session, led by our wonderful facilitators, Aasma Jabeed, Awaad deen, Divya deen, and Diksha deen. They introduced us to the mission of Oasis and encouraged us to share our own stories. In a fun, interactive activity, we formed pairs and introduced one another. The energy in the room was palpable as we called out "Shang!" and welcomed more friends into our groups, making it a powerful icebreaker. This marked the beginning of our journey understanding our goals on a deeper level.

After lunch, we dove into our second session, where our facilitators shared their personal stories—how they took a stand and began changing mindsets through Oasis from an early age. It was during this inspiring session that I realized I didn't have to wait until I was older to make a difference; I could start making an impact right now.

When we were asked to submit our photos, I initially felt frustrated. I worried that without a phone, I would be bored and miss out on my favorite snacks, outlining the steps we would take to achieve those goals. In the final two days, we were given project planner pages consisting of six segments. The first step required us to identify our key skills that would support our project, followed by defining our goals and answering five "why" questions for each. Initially daunting, the process became manageable with the support of my teammates, who helped us tackle the challenges effectively.

In a world where we often turn to Google or AI for answers, being without our phones pushed us to rely on our knowledge and creativity. I discovered the joy of engaging deeply with questions, leading to clarity and igniting my passion for problem-solving. We even watched films related to our goals and projects, which further enriched our learning. I am immensely grateful to the Oasis team members who organized such impactful programs and to the facilitators who imparted invaluable lessons. Before this experience, I would feel a wave of nerves wash over me whenever I spoke on stage at school, struggling to hold the microphone. Yet, when I returned from Srinagar, I had the opportunity to share my experiences with my classmates. To my astonishment, I realized that my fear had evaporated over those six transformative days.

Thank you, Oasis, for opening and introducing me to the possibilities and for fostering connections which will last a lifetime!

Working in line for food became an exercise in patience, reminding us that in this space, everyone was equal—regardless of wealth or status, we were all friends.

On the second day, we received a page with prompts to write about our goals and our motivations behind them. After a refreshing break, we were tasked with

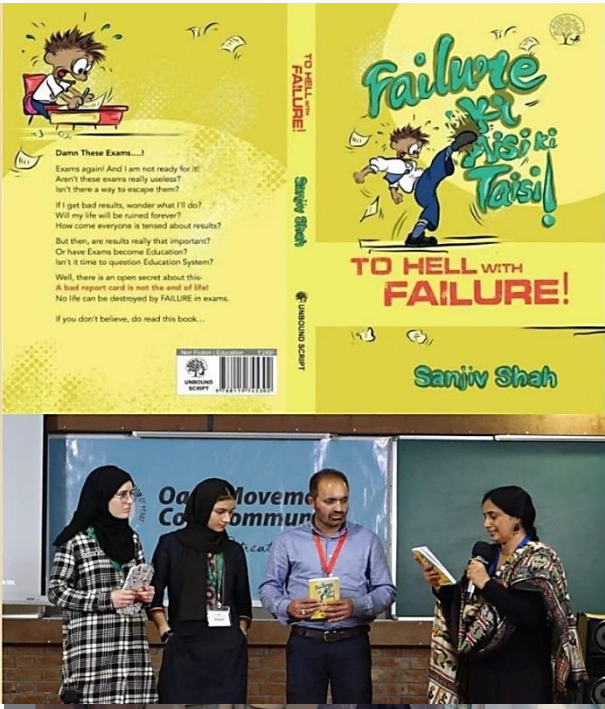

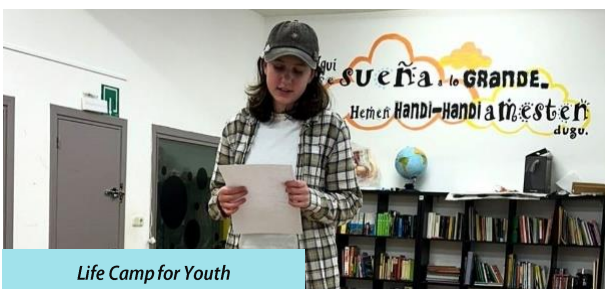

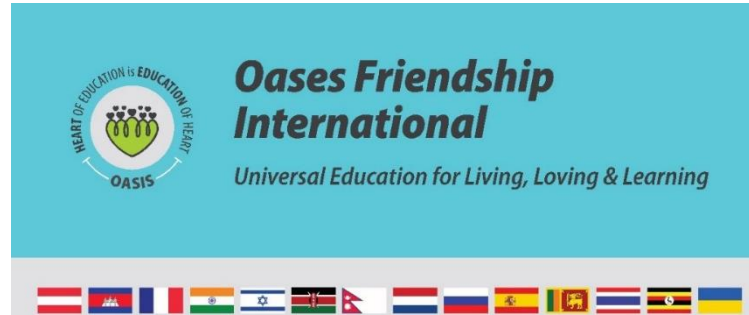
